WDFW has concluded that there are no exceptions to the requirement to provide proof of compliance with the clean water act. "All motorized beach prospecting will be removed from the Gold and Fish pamphlet and require a standard HPA".

You can still take sand and process in your campsite but you must take your own water and not leave it there, the way it is written... Always check with the park rangers each time... Tom

CAMP/PICNIC QUICK TIPS

Jeanne and I would like to ask you to submit your tips for camping and picnics.

Email your suggestions/tips to Debbie W. at <u>ddwitch-er@yahoo.com</u>. Here are a few examples:

- 1) Cooking on an open fire? Coat the outside of the pan with dish detergent. The smoke and grit buildup from the fire with wash right off. No scrubbing cleanup is a breeze!
- 2) Have a pitcher or air-tight container with a pour spout.

 Crack your eggs into the container (don't break the yoks). The eggs will stay suspended in the whites. Makes for easy safe

transportation. When you are ready to use the eggs just pour out one at a time as needed. No more broken eggs in camp fridge or cooler.

3) Stick candle wick into the sides of a pinecone leaving about one inch at the top for lighting. Pour melted wax over the cone. When wax has cooled, ready to use as a fire starter.

Also, you can put dryer lint into an egg carton, pour over it, let it cool and cut the carton into individual sections. You now have 12/18 instant fire starters. Just light the carton.

Ok, now we got you started let's have those ideas!!
